CALL TO ORDER, MOMENT OF SILENCE

Chairman Moss called the special meeting to order to ratify action taken during a local emergency at 2:00 p.m. in the former Board Room, Palmyra, Virginia. Chairman Moss also called for a moment of silence in honor of the passing of Henry Browning, a former Board of Supervisors member.

ACTION MATTERS

Confirmation of Local Emergency Declaration

This action is consistent with the requirements of the Code of Virginia Emergency Services and Disaster Law. On Saturday, December 19th 2009, staff contacted Chairman Moss in his capacity as the Director of Emergency Services and provided him with a briefing on the local emergency response situation which included road closures and sheltering of stranded motorists. Upon staff's request and recommendation, Chairman Moss declared a local emergency. The Code of Virginia requires that such action be followed with confirmation of such action by the full Board of Supervisors within fourteen (14) days.

MOTION:

Mr. Allbaugh moved to confirm the decision to declare a local emergency on Saturday, December 19th 2009 in response to a significant winter storm event. Mr. Gooch seconded. The motion carried with a vote of 6-0. AYES: Allbaugh, Booker, Gooch, Ott, Weaver and Moss. NAYS: None.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Mr. G. Cabell Lawton, IV, County Administrator, commended Garland Nuckols, Director of Facilities, and his facilities crew for all their help and effort in handling the emergencies that arose due to the winter storm.
