

**PUBLIC NOTICE BY THE JAMES RIVER WATER AUTHORITY OF RECEIPT OF
UNSOLICITED PPEA PROPOSAL AND INVITATION FOR COMPETING
PROPOSALS**

The James River Water Authority has received and accepted for evaluation an unsolicited proposal to design and construct a water supply system utilizing the James River as a source. The primary objective of the project is to design and construct a comprehensive utility system which will provide a reliable and adequate water supply from the James River. The proposed project will consist of a new river water intake and pump station at or near the Town of Columbia in Fluvanna County. Additionally, the project will include the construction of a raw water pipeline segment that will terminate in the vicinity of the Colonial Pipeline easement on the north side of State Route 6. The project will provide a point of connection on the raw water pipeline for the continuation of raw water and other water system facilities by each of the Authority member Counties of Fluvanna and Louisa. The James River Water Authority invites other interested parties to submit competing proposals according to the terms and conditions of its Guidelines for Implementation of the Public-Private Educational Facilities and Infrastructure Act of 2002 (PPEA) for simultaneous consideration, available at <http://www.fluvannacounty.org/business/jrwa>. The James River Water Authority intends to evaluate the proposal(s) and may negotiate an interim or comprehensive agreement with proposer(s) based on the proposals received.
