- Virginia Public Records Act (VPRA) and the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)
 - Changes in effect July 1, 2016

VPRA:

- Clerk to the Board will serve as Records Officer for departments under the County Administrator
 - Administrative Departments will also appoint a Records Coordinator
- Constitutional Officers and Agencies must also appoint a formal Records
 Officer to coordinate record inventories, destruction schedules, and
 ensuring records retention complies with the State Code.

FOIA:

- Requires certain local public bodies to post a FOIA rights and responsibilities document on their respective public government website.
- Clerk to the Board will serve as FOIA Officer for departments under the County Administrator
- Constitutional Officers and Agencies must also appoint a formal FOIA
 Officer



- VDOT bridge crews are planning to replace two Fluvanna County structures later this summer and fall.
 - Route 652 -- Academy Road (Near FUMA)
 - Replace the steel beams and timber deck with new galvanized steel and new timber deck. Substructures will also require major rehabilitation.
 - Plan to close the structure in July and open again late August.
 - Route 629 -- Deep Creek Rd (near Dogwood Drive)
 - Replace the steel beams and timber deck with new galvanized steel and new timber deck.
 - Plan to close the structure in November and open before January.
- Schedules and detour routes will be shared when finalized.
- VDOT will also coordinate with area schools and EMS for impacted routes.

 - Bridlewood properties improved water flow after the last storm.


