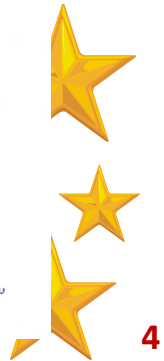

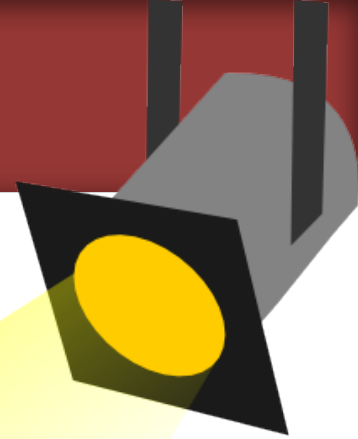

- Description: We are a small, pasture-based/grass-fed meat and spray-free, GMO-free produce and hop farm. We offer a seasonal *CSA membership, and our products are also available on-farm and at the Fluvanna County Farmer's Market.
- *CSA (Community Supported Agriculture) is a way for consumers to buy local, seasonal food, directly from their farmer.

CSA Membership - You sign up for a share/ membership, and in return receive a box of fresh vegetables, eggs, meat of your choice, and cut flowers each week, throughout the growing season. Typically, the membership is paid-in-full at the beginning of the season.
