

Announcements and Updates

- May 13 <u>CDC Interim Public Health Recommendations for Fully</u> <u>Vaccinated People</u> released
- May 13 <u>Amended Executive Order 72</u>
 - As of midnight, May 15 Mask Mandate lifted for individuals who are fully vaccinated
 - Employees of certain businesses will continue to be required to cover faces while at their place of employment in accordance with <u>CDC guidance</u>.
- May 28 <u>Executive Order 79</u> lifts all Commonsense Public Health Restrictions Due to Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)
 - <u>EO 79, section D</u>: All students, teachers, staff, and visitors must wear a mask over their nose and mouth while on school property subject to section C.
 (section C outlines exceptions to requirements for wearing a mask)
