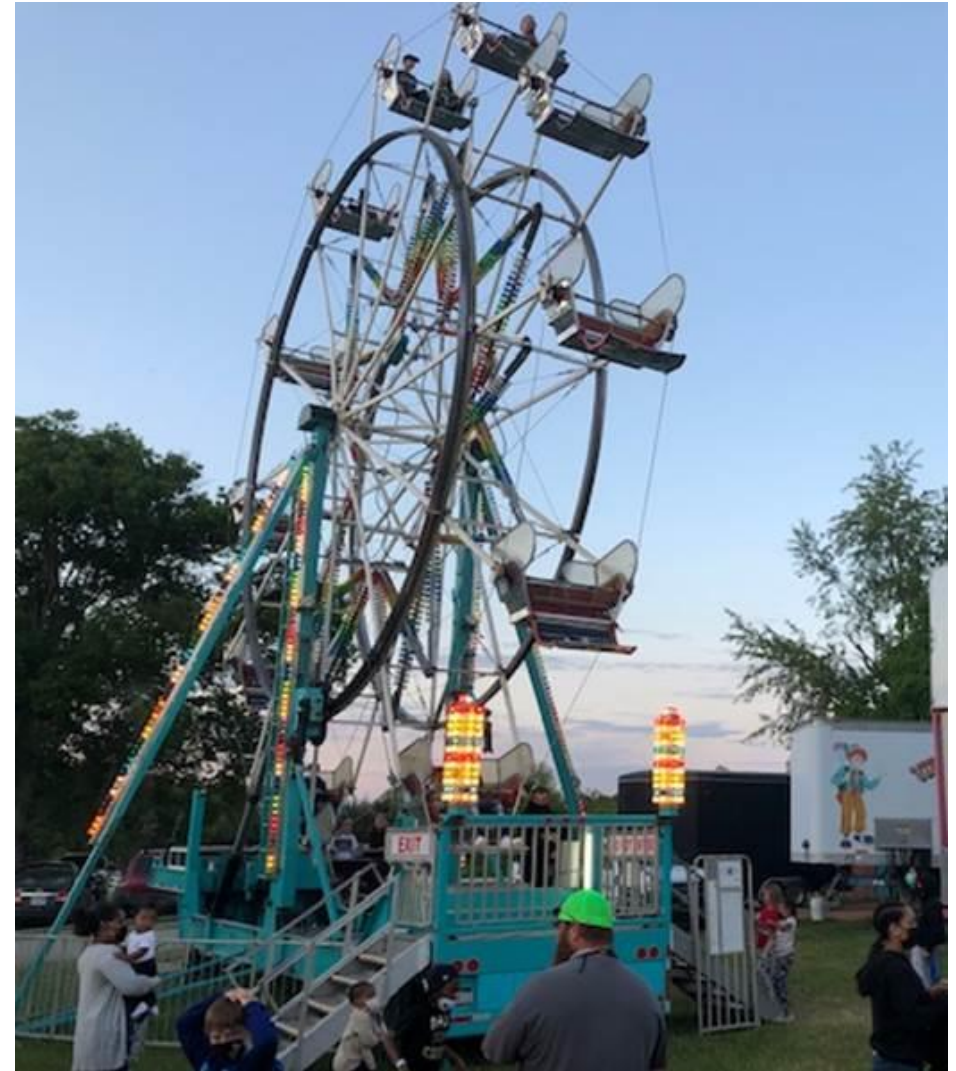
Fluvanna County May Carnival

- **May 13 - [CDC Interim Public Health Recommendations for Fully Vaccinated People](#) released**
- **May 13 - [Amended Executive Order 72](#)**
 - As of midnight, May 15 – Mask Mandate lifted for individuals who are **fully vaccinated**
 - Employees of certain businesses will continue to be required to cover faces while at their place of employment in accordance with [CDC guidance](#).
- **May 28 – [Executive Order 79](#) lifts all Commonsense Public Health Restrictions Due to Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)**
 - [EO 79, section D](#): *All students, teachers, staff, and visitors must wear a mask over their nose and mouth while on school property subject to section C.*
(section C outlines exceptions to requirements for wearing a mask)
