- Take time to register with the County's emergency notification system
 - CodeRED® High-Speed Notification Messaging System
 - CodeRED® system provides county officials the ability to quickly deliver messages to targeted areas or the entire county.
- Gives individuals and businesses the ability to add their own phone numbers directly into the system's database
 - Required information includes first and last name, street address (physical address, no P.O. boxes), city, state, zip code, and primary phone number; additional phone numbers can be entered as well.
 - All businesses should register, as well as all individuals who have unlisted phone numbers, changed their phone number or address within the past year, and those who use a cellular phone or VoIP phone as their primary number.
