*FREE Prescription drug disposal and Hazardous waste drop-off for county residents only (households, not businesses)


Will include paints, pesticides, solvents, cleaners, etc. waste tire drop-off (w/out rims) from cars, trucks, ATV's, etc.

Visual Monthly VDOT Projects Summary








Spotlight on Business in Fluvanna

One Year in Business Anniversaries in April:

- Small Town Precision Service Company
 - Providing Commercial Outdoor Maintenance Services
- Willow Creek Lawn and Garden
 - Providing Landscape Design and Landscape Services



- Postponed "Look at Fire Rescue" Class until late summer
- New Offering "Community CPR Day" on May 17
 - Event will provide CPR training and certification for community members, as well as provide personal preparedness information (including an emergency "go-bag" from Jefferson Pharmacy.)
 - Advance registration is required.





- Looking for a citizen representative for the Community Policy and Management Team (CPMT)
 - Meetings are held on the fourth Tuesday of the month at the Fluvanna Department of Social Services
 - CPMT creates, maintains and manages a collaborative system of services and funding that is child centered, family focused and community based when addressing the strengths and needs of troubled and at-risk youth and their families.

Virginia Stormwater Management Program (VSMP)

- Required local implementation date is July 1, 2014
- Still engaged with local VSMP Ordinance review process with DEQ
- New law signed March 24th amending the Stormwater Management Act to limit the number of localities that must adopt local programs and included several other amendments ("Opt Out" Option)
- Amendments require that eight (8) new provisions be incorporated into local VSMP ordinances by May 15, 2014

- Under the new law, Fluvanna is not required to adopt a local VSMP
- Deadline for initial "opt in" or "opt out" is April 30, 2014
- DEQ is still developing a new automated permit registration system
- DEQ has not provided VSMP plan review training for localities

Staff Recommendation

- Fluvanna County "opt out" of implementing the VSMP at this time
- Advantageous to most non-MS4 (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems), rural localities, to have DEQ manage the program until such time as would be necessary to ensure that:
 - Local staff receives all required training and certification,
 - State's automated permit registration system and associated program/project tracking processes have matured,
 - There has been sufficient time for localities to observe and interact with program implementation as administered by DEQ statewide,
 - State ordinance is no longer experiencing frequent or substantial change.
