- NREMT (National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians)
 - All 9 eligible students passed their National exam on the first attempt!
 - 5 individuals received scores much higher than the national average! (National average 84%, Fluvanna Course 97%)
- Reflects progress in our emergency response and the continuing dedication of our all volunteer Fire Department.
- Already seen benefits of their training on several serious or potentially serious 911 calls in Fluvanna

County Radon Awareness Initiative

- This Week at the Lake host, Jay Brown, will present a special television program on radon. He will be interviewing Carolynne Hagan, chemistry teacher at FCHS and Cheryl Wilkins.
- Radon kits are available for pickup at the LMOA Operations Building beginning September 5th. These test results will be added to our growing numbers through the Health Dept. to give us a better idea of radon levels in the County.
- We were able to secure an additional 200 free kits through VDH for distribution.

- September is National Preparedness Month
 - The Ready Campaign calls for all Americans to take the time to understand the risks in their communities to take that one additional step and practice what to do in advance of an emergency, and plan how to reconnect with family members after a disaster.


